REGISTRATION OF ADDITIONAL SECURITIES

Pursuant to a registration statement on Form S-8 filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the Commission) on January 21, 2005, (File No. 333-122231) (the First Registration Statement), Integrated Device Technology, Inc. (the Company) registered 2,500,000 shares of its Common Stock issuable under the 2004 Equity Plan. Pursuant to a registration statement on Form S-8 filed with the Commission on September 16, 2005, (File No. 333-128376) (the Second Registration Statement), the Company registered 17,000,000 shares of its Common Stock issuable under the 2004 Plan. Pursuant to a registration statement on Form S-8 filed with the Commission on October 25, 2006, (File No. 333-138205) (the Third Registration Statement), the Company registered 5,000,000 shares of its Common Stock issuable under the 2004 Plan. Pursuant to a registration statement on Form S-8 filed with the Commission on October 28, 2008, (File No. 333-154776) (the Fourth Registration Statement), the Company registered 4,000,000 shares of its Common Stock issuable under the 2004 Plan. The Company is hereby registering 8,300,000 shares of its Common Stock issuable under the 2004 Plan.

Pursuant to general instruction E of Form S-8, the contents of the First Registration Statement, the Second Registration Statement, the Third Registration Statement and the Fourth Registration Statement are incorporated by reference herein.

(b) The Company's Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended June 27, 2010, filed with the Commission on August 4, 2010, including all material incorporated by reference therein;

(c) The Company's Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended September 26, 2010, filed with the Commission on November 3, 2010, including all material incorporated by reference therein;

(d) All other reports filed pursuant to Sections 13(a) or 15(d) of the Exchange Act since the end of the fiscal year covered by the annual report referred to in (a) above; and

(e) The description of the Company's common stock contained in the Company's registration statement on Form 8-A (Registration No. 001-12695), filed by the Company with the Commission under Section 12(b) of the Exchange Act, on July 23, 1984, including any amendments or reports filed for the purpose of updating such description.

All documents subsequently filed by the Company pursuant to Sections 13(a), 13(c), 14 and 15(d) of the Exchange Act after the date of this Registration Statement and prior to the filing of a post-effective amendment to the Registration Statement which indicates that all securities offered hereby have been sold or which deregisters all of such securities then remaining unsold, shall be deemed to be incorporated by reference herein and to be a part of this Registration Statement from the date of the filing of such documents, except as to any portion of any future annual or quarterly report to stockholders or document or current report furnished under current Item 2.02 and Item 7.01 and any related exhibits furnished under Item 9.01 of Form 8-K that is not deemed filed under such provisions. Any statement contained in a document incorporated or deemed to be incorporated by reference herein shall be deemed to be modified or superseded for purposes of this Registration Statement to the extent that a statement contained in this Registration Statement, or in any other subsequently filed document which also is or is deemed to be incorporated by reference in this Registration Statement, modifies or supersedes such statement. Any such statement so modified or superseded shall not be deemed, except as so modified or superseded, to constitute a part of this Registration Statement.

Under no circumstances will any information filed under current items 2.02 and 7.01 and any related exhibits furnished under Item 9.01 of Form 8-K be deemed incorporated herein by reference unless such Form 8-K expressly provides to the contrary.

In addition, the Registrant carries director and officer liability insurance.

(i) To include any prospectus required by Section 10(a)(3) of the Securities Act;

(ii) To reflect in the prospectus any facts or events arising after the effective date of this Registration Statement (or the most recent post-effective amendment thereof) which, individually or in the aggregate, represent a fundamental change in the information set forth in this Registration Statement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any increase or decrease in volume of securities offered (if the total dollar value of securities offered would not exceed that which was registered) and any deviation from the low or high end of the estimated maximum offering range may be reflected in the form of prospectus filed with the Commission pursuant to Rule 424(b) if, in the aggregate, the changes in volume and price represent no more than 20 percent change in the maximum aggregate offering price set forth in the Calculation of Registration Fee table in the effective Registration Statement; and

(iii) To include any material information with respect to the plan of distribution not previously disclosed in the Registration Statement or any material change to such information in the Registration Statement;

provided, however, that paragraphs (i) and (ii) do not apply if the Registration Statement is on Form S-8, and the information required to be included in a post-effective amendment by those paragraphs is contained in periodic reports filed with or furnished to the Commission by the Registrant pursuant to Section 13 or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 that are incorporated by reference in the Registration Statement.

(2) That, for the purpose of determining any liability under the Securities Act, each such post-effective amendment shall be deemed to be a new Registration Statement relating to the securities offered therein, and the offering of such securities at that time shall be deemed to be the initial *bona fide* offering thereof; and

(3) To remove from registration by means of a post-effective amendment any of the securities being registered which shall remain unsold at the termination of the offering.

(b) The undersigned Company hereby undertakes that, for purposes of determining any liability under the Securities Act, each filing of the Company's annual report pursuant to Section 13(a) or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (and, where applicable, each filing of an employee benefit plan's annual report pursuant to Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934) that is incorporated by reference in the Registration Statement shall be deemed to be a new registration statement relating to the securities offered therein, and the offering of such securities at that time shall be deemed to be the initial *bona fide* offering thereof.

(c) Insofar as indemnification for liabilities arising under the Securities Act may be permitted to directors, officers and controlling persons of the Company pursuant to the foregoing provisions, or otherwise, the Company has been advised that in the opinion of the Commission such indemnification is against public policy as expressed in the Act and is, therefore, unenforceable. In the event that a claim for indemnification against such liabilities (other than the payment by the Company of expenses incurred or paid by a director, officer or controlling person of the Company in the successful defense of any action, suit or proceeding) is asserted by such director, officer or controlling person in connection with the securities being registered, the Company will, unless in the opinion of its counsel the matter has been settled by controlling precedent, submit to a court of appropriate jurisdiction the question whether such indemnification by it is against public policy as expressed in the Act and will be governed by the final adjudication of such issue.
