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In April 2002, the registrant and two subsidiaries, American Express Centurion Bank and American Express Credit Corporation (Credco), renegotiated their committed credit line facilities. Total available credit lines are \$11.45 billion, including \$1.5 billion allocated to the registrant and \$9.35 billion allocated to Credco. As of April 30, 2002, Credco's allocated committed bank line coverage of its net short-term debt was 76%. Credco has the right to borrow up to a maximum amount of \$10.85 billion, with a commensurate reduction in the amount available to the registrant. These facilities expire in increments from 2003 through 2007.
