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## Item 5. Other Events.

On April 3, 2003, the Company announced the jury verdict related to the recent patent infringement allegation against Superconductor Technologies, Inc. and its wholly-owned subsidiary, Conductus, Inc. (STI).

The jury agreed with STI s argument that the Company s patent (U.S. Patent No. 6,263,215, entitled Cryoelectronically Cooled Receiver Front End for Mobile Radio Systems ) was invalid and unenforceable and that its Superfilter® III product is not infringing. The jury also awarded STI $\$ 3.87 \mathrm{MM}$ against the Company as damages for what STI claimed to be unfair competition on the part of the Company.
