Fidelity Investments Institutional Services Company, Inc. accounts for holdings in the stock fund in units, comprised of stock and cash reserves. The shares reported represent an approximate value based upon the fund balance and market value of Issuer's common stock.

(3) This option became exercisable in four equal annual installments beginning on this date.

(4) Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of HP common stock.

Dividend equivalent rights accrue with respect to these RSUs when and as dividends are paid on HP common stock. The number of derivative securities beneficially owned in column 9 includes 13.7562 dividend equivalent rights at \$41.18 per RSU credited to the reporting person's account on 04/06/11.
