Explanation of Responses:

- (1) On January 22, 2013, a "target" award of 8,500 performance restricted stock units (RSUs) was granted to the reporting person pursuant to the Amended and Restated Comerica Incorporated 2006 Long-Term Incentive Plan. The RSUs are settled in stock, with accrued dividend equivalents paid out annually in cash. The RSUs vest in one installment at the end of a three-year performance period. If, during any year in such performance period, Comerica falls below the Tier 1 Capital Threshold defined by the Federal Reserve for well capitalized banks, 15% of the RSU target award will be forfeited, with a maximum reduction of 45% of the target award. On February 25, 2014, the Governance, Compensation and Nominating Committee of Comerica Incorporated certified that performance was achieved for the 2013 fiscal year. The number of RSUs reported in this Form 4 represents the additional portion of the award that is not subject to reduction due to the achievement of the 2013 performance results.

- (3) The options vest in four equal annual installments beginning on the date indicated in this column.
