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#### ITEM 9. REGULATION FD DISCLOSURE

As a result of the incident that damaged the ATWOOD BEACON on July 25, 2004, the rig's contract in Indonesia has been terminated with effect from July 28, 2004 pursuant to force majuere notice provision. The drilling unit has been transported to the builder's shipyard in Singapore and is currently being inspected. The Company has begun the process of recovering the legs which, when recovered, will be transported to the builder's shipyard in Singapore. Until all the legs have been transported to Singapore and inspected, which is estimated to be around mid-September 2004, the Company will not be able to determine the repair period for the rig. The Company expects the drilling unit to be under a contract following its repairs.

Additional information with respect to the Company's Contract Status Summary at August 12, 2004 is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 which is being furnished in accordance with Rule 101(e)(1) under Regulation FD and should not be deemed to be filed.

Statements contained in this report with respect to the future are forward-looking statements. These statements reflect management's reasonable judgment with respect to future events. Forward-looking statements involve risks and uncertainties.
