Common Units are redeemable for cash or, at the option of the Issuer, convertible into shares of the Issuer's common stock based on a conversion ratio described in the partnership agreement of Subsidiary, which, on March 30, 2016, was 0.9543908329 shares of the Issuer's common stock for each Common Unit.
